Prince Street Gallery is pleased to announce Arthur Levine's first solo show of paintings and drawings since 2014.



Levine depicts landscapes, cityscapes and ships as densely structured vessels of space and light. They are shifting volumes and voids, historical and remembered. While his paintings are figurative, his process is more closely aligned with expressionism. The intent is to use the material of the paint to create expansive, luminous spaces that invoke movement, inherent and ever potential. His drawings, by contrast, are done directly from nature, in line, with a minimum of modeling. Both processes are attempts to explore the material essence of a subject.

Arthur Levine lives and works in Brooklyn and Garratsville, NY. He has been featured in numerous group and solo shows in the United States. Levine's work is in the permanent collections of MoMA, NY, Walker Art Center, Mn, Art Institute of Chicago and more. He is the recipient of several awards and fellowships such as the Fellowship in Painting from the National Endowments of the Arts and a Fulbright Grant. Levine is a member of Prince Street Gallery.
