In her 4th solo show at Prince Street Gallery, Higgins continues to explore the abstract relationships of form and color using the landscape and the figure as her muse.

This exhibition will be accompanied by a catalogue with an essay by the artist and critic, John Goodrich, Professor of Painting, National Academy of Design, NYC.
