Gerald Marcus New Work February 27 – March 24, 2018 Reception: Thursday, March 1, 5-8 PM

The Prince Street Gallery announces an exhibition of new work by Gerald Marcus, to run February 27 to March 24, 2018. The gallery is open Tuesday through Saturday, 11:00 AM-6:00 PM. The opening reception will be March 1, 5-8 PM.

The exhibition will consist of landscapes of the Adirondack Mountains, in upstate New York, the Lake District in England and the Negev and Golan Heights in Israel as well as figure compositions. The show will include oils, watercolors, etchings and drawings.

Marcus' work portrays the distant vistas and sense of big space that are typical of mountain landscapes, and as a counterpoint, intimate forest interiors, streams and ponds that emphasize a pastoral, elegiac beauty. He works outdoors, directly from the motif, as well as in the studio.

Marcus has shown his work in many one-man shows and group shows in New York City and nationally including, The National Academy of Design, The International Print Center of New York, The Lancaster Museum of Art, the Hunterdon Museum of Art, The Morris Museum of Art, The Hollar Society Prague, Smith College, The City University of New York, Long Island University and Purdue University. He is a former president of the Society of American Graphic Artists.
