**Grant Drumheller** is a figurative painter, working in large and small formats. In addition to Prince Street Gallery, his work is shown at Greenhut Gallery, Portland, ME and The Elder Gallery of Contemporary Art, Charlotte, NC. Drumheller has received numerous awards and fellowships for his work, most recently enjoying an artist in residence at The American Academy in Rome. **Arthur Kvarnstrom's** early work was based on direct observation. This has not changed. What has changed is his intent. **Stewart Siskind** draws from his early career as an art director in New York. It is here that he mastered the use of printed matter as a central element in the composition and design of collage. In his recent work done during quarantine, the artist uses strong color, torn edges and shadow play.
