Grant Drumheller, Paintings The City and the Sea September 3-28, 2019. Reception September 5, 5-8

Grant Drumheller will present his third show at the Prince Street Gallery opening on September 5, 2019. The paintings in the show feature richly colored and evocative images of people from above, gathering and moving through cities and along beaches, in addition to works of fishermen and diggers, those who make a living from the sea.

The show is accompanied by a catalog with an essay by Michael Taav. "Grant's excellent new collection demonstrates both his bold willingness to tackle new subjects and his ability to imbue each painting with the qualities that have long distinguished his work. Each piece in this collection clearly reveals the originality of his interpretation, his technical mastery, and his talent for employing clean, strong colors to create vigorous, active figures—the end result being a painting that offers the viewer such a profusion of visual pleasures that the more one looks, the more one sees." Taav is a painter, author, and award-winning film maker.

Drumheller has been the recipient of a Fulbright-Hays Grant in Painting to Italy. He has also been the recipient of a Blanche Colman Award, a National Endowment for the Arts Artist's Fellowship, a New England Foundation for the Arts Grant and a grant from the Pollock- Krasner Foundation. Most recently he was a Visiting Artist at the American Academy in Rome in 2009. He is Professor Emeritus of Art at the University of New Hampshire.

Drumheller has had numerous exhibitions, including one person shows at the Galleria Inquadratura (Florence, Italy), the Currier Museum of Art (Manchester, NH) the Creiger-Dane Gallery (Boston, MA), the Grace Institute (New York, NY), The Prince Street Gallery (New York, NY), Boston University, Amherst College and the Nesto Gallery at Milton Academy (MA). 2015 brought a 40-painting review at Gordon College (Wenham, MA). This year, Drumheller will exhibit at the Prince Street Gallery, New York, NY, The Elder Gallery of Contemporary Art (Charlotte, NC), and Cove Street Arts (Portland, ME). In addition, his work is represented by the Greenhut Galleries, Portland, ME, and the George Marshall Store Gallery, York Harbor, ME.
