

Barbara Feldberg: A Life Lived

Prince Street Gallery is pleased to announce the solo exhibition of Barbara Feldberg.

The works shown by Barbara Feldberg have been painted on three continents and in six cities over a period of sixty years. Whether working in London where she grew up or in the cities of Cape Town, New Orleans, Chicago or New York; the landscapes and quality of light have had a profound influence on her work. Memories, emotional reactions and flights of fancy have accompanied her from place to place.

From the gentle greyness of London to the dazzling light of Cape Town, stories and people have been captured at different moments and in different eras. Over a period of six decades, she has painted the pastime of lawn bowling in Cape Town and in New York's Central Park and swimming in pools on different continents. Similarly, many of her intimate portraits of friends and family mark the progression of the years. She carries these beloved people with her from place to place, recording the passage of time.

In 1960 Barbara Feldberg painted "Snowscape, Camden Town, London." Her recent large painting is "Winter, Central Park," 2020. She has come full circle. In recording the present, she has paid homage to her sixteen-year-old self.
