Stewart Siskind's solo show **FINDINGS**, his third at Prince Street Gallery, reflects the path that led the artist to doing art fulltime, the work he has done and where his art practice is today.

Siskind has been intrigued by printed matter since working as an art director and graphic designer in New York City. His love of the medium has inspired him to breathe new life and meaning into often discarded material. Creating intricate collages from torn paper that resonate with bold graphic structures and subtle psychological undercurrents.

Siskind's black and white photographs are inspired by travels to Italy, his paper collage and love of vintage photography. Siskind started using original photography as a key element during the pandemic and began doing digital collage. His fascination with texture, worn surfaces and use of framing lend themselves to prints rich in tone and composition.

Stewart Siskind earned a BFA in Graphic Design from the School of Visual Arts in Manhattan and did postgraduate study at New York University and Parsons School of Design. His work has received numerous awards for art direction and design and has been published in professional journals. Two posters he designed are in the permanent collection of The Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum.

A native of Brooklyn, he currently lives and works in Manhattan.
