Prince Street Gallery presents *The Path of Water*, a collection of radiant landscapes by Pearl Rosen Golden, on view from February 25 – March 22, 2025. Her paintings explore the essence of ocean rhythms and the light and form of trees and vegetation, inspired by the Long Beach, NY coast and Seattle's lush Pacific Northwest—places she calls home.

The exhibition reflects Rosen Golden's connection to these environments and her ongoing exploration of nature's forms, patterns, and vitality. Water, both as a literal medium and a conceptual symbol, runs throughout the show, representing growth, transformation, and the continuous flow of energy in the natural world.

The exhibition highlights the evolution of her work, organized around three central themes: *Beach Series*, *Seattle Woods*, and *Water-Influenced Abstracts*. Working with gouache and inks, she delves into color and expression. The *Beach Series* reflects coastal hues with gouache, while her *Water-Influenced Abstracts* use vibrant inks to portray the fluidity of organic forms and growth.

Pearl Rosen Golden is presenting her second solo exhibition at Prince Street Gallery and fourth in Manhattan. She also exhibits with ArtMa Pop-Up Group in Bellevue, WA, and is part of Fluid Media, showcasing in-person and online through the SHIM Art Network on Artsy. Her work is in corporate and private collections, as well as museum-held print portfolios.
